A few copyright basics:



- Automatic subsistence
 - (NO REGISTRATION)



- Subject to:
 - Reduction to material form
 - Originality



 Author being "qualified" (SA resident) OR work created or first published in RSA





- through the Berne Convention
- protection into and out of RSA
- foreign protection based on foreign law
- generally automatic





Ownership

- author (defined) is usually the owner unless:
- under contract of employment
- certain commissioned works
- assignment (in writing) to another
- copyright in relation to state and international organisations
 - made under direction or control of state or prescribed international organisations

Categories

- Several different categories of works
 - artistic
 - literary (including data)
 - musical
 - sound recordings
 - cinematograph films
 - programme carrying signals
 - broadcasts
 - computer programs
 - Each has its own definitions

Owner has exclusive rights

Typically has right to:

- reproduce
- publish
- perform in public
- broadcast
- adapt
- include in a cinematograph film or television broadcast



Duration of copyright

- Generally
 - life of author plus 50 years from end of the year in which author dies
 - 50 years from end of year in which work is published, performed, broadcasted, emitted etc.
- Each category has its own definition

Infringement of copyright

Two types of infringement:

- Direct when any of the copyright owner's exclusive are performed
- Indirect, when any trade or dealing takes place in respect of articles which infringe copyright (knowledge is a requirement)

Remedies for infringement

- interdict
- removal of offending mark/delivery-up of infringing goods
- damages
- in lieu of damages, reasonable royalty
